### The confirmations of the participants' organisations

1. - fishery and aquaculture sector, as covered by Regulation (EU) No 1379/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council.

3. The amount of *de minimis* aid granted by the beneficiary is based on the Commission Regulation (EU) No 1407/2013, 1408/2013 and 717/2014 (or any regulation replacing it) together with the *de minimis* aid from the programme does not exceed the *de minimis* aid ceiling 200 000 euros during the current and two previous fiscal years.
